



Technical Control Commission Report 2018



At the end of this first year of activity of the new world organization WKSF, during which we have seen two important events, the World Championship held in Italy (21-24 June, Vanzaghello-Milan) and the European Championship in Portugal (8-11 November, Maia-Porto), we can make some evaluations regarding the technical and organizational aspects related to WKSF competitions.

The reference for the technical analysis is the document "WKSF requirements for the organization of the World Championship and the European Championship" which draws the guidelines of what is deemed necessary in organizing the events in the name of WKSF.

Our analysis for this first year refers exclusively to the two events mentioned above, World Championship and European Championship.

In both cases we have been able to verify that the requirements contained in the document "WKSF requirements for the organization of the World Championship and the European Championship" have been met in an excellent manner, fulfilling all the points provided by the guideline and summarized below:

- Obtain, where possible, the recognition by the State or by a body responsible for the development of sport at National level and/or Sponsorships by public bodies (eg Region, Municipality, etc.)
- Organize or provide the necessary information regarding transfer services from and to airport, train station, bus etc.
- Select a sports Hall suitable either from the point of view of the image and comfort and for the availability of services.
- Select and give information on the availability of Hotels or other type of accommodation (B & B, etc.) within 10 Km. from the event location and the necessary information regarding transfer services
- The competition platforms must be of the standard size of 150 x 150 cm.
- Protection for accidental falls of the kettlebells during the race must not be visible
- Kettlebells must comply with the standards defined by WKSF;
- Monitor for each race platform
- Banner of length 20/22 m. x 3/4 m. height to be placed inside the competition area.
- Vertical banners or roll-ups of 240 cm. in height x 120 cm. of width, with the WKSF logo.
- Banner for the prize-giving area, length 5/6 m. x 3 m. height, with the logo of the Championship, of the organizers and sponsors
- Podium with positions for 1st - 2nd - 3rd classified, with the Championship logo
- Video streaming during the event
- Video streaming during the conference that will be announced on one of the days of the event
- Organize a prestigious opening ceremony of the championship
- Promote the event by press, on social networks (e.g. facebook) and, if possible, on television media
- Prepare what is necessary for the awards as foreseen by WKSF:

One of our goals is also the continuous improvement, and for this reason we add some indications on what we consider useful to do, for an even better presentation and realization of events, regarding the operative positions of the Jury, the Secretariat/Competition Speaker and the Technical support (voice management / music / video)

The suggestion is to physically separate the working areas by creating three distinct areas, one for each function:

- Jury
- Secretarial, timekeeping and competition speaker
- Technical Team (voice / music / video management)

It is also recommended to avoid stowing material in the judges and secretaries area, using the wardrobe space for judges and make sure that only the authorized personnel can access the competition area to take photos or video, no other person should access in particular during the competition.

I conclude by saying that I have greatly appreciated the friendly and healthy competitive spirit that was breathed in the two events and I hope that this positive approach will continue in the future.
